



FIGURE SKATING COACHES POLICY

North Shore Ice Arena houses a group of staff coaches that are committed to the success of the facility. These coaches are permitted to use the facility, including Freestyle Ice, to train their skaters.

Any coach not listed as a staff coach, will be considered a visiting coach, and must obtain approval from the Figure Skating Director before using the facility to teach private lessons. North Shore Ice Arena has the right to refuse any visiting coach the opportunity to teach private lessons at the facility if there is reason to believe it is not in the best interest their staff, professionals or students.

VISITING COACH POLICY

Visiting coaches must fill out a “Visiting Coach” information sheet and present a copy of his/her liability insurance which will be kept on file.

(No coach will be allowed on the ice without current liability insurance)

Visiting coach will be contacted by the Figure Skating Director, within 5 days of application, on the status and guidelines of using North Shore Ice Arena.

Upon approval, any visiting coach must pay a \$20/month visiting coach fee. Coach will be given a “Visiting Coach” card which needs to be renewed each month.
